"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life, and have *it* abundantly." – John 10:10 (NASB)

January 1, 2007. As we watched the ball drop last night, Dave and I hugged each other in massive relief. We had survived the worst year of our lives! No one in our immediate family had died or been stricken ill, but many of our extended family, church family and friends had. Instead, personally our year had been filled with an expensive, contentious court battle that literally sucked every bit of money, as well as physical and emotional energy we had. We could hardly contain our excitement that the year is now over.

A few weeks ago, one of my favorite TV preachers cited this scripture from John as the beginning of teaching on how to live life abundantly. As Pastor Jim said in a recent sermon, abundance is NOT about material abundance, but more about being abundant in the fruits that come from the Spirit. Love...Joy...Peace are at the top of that list!

Yes, that's exactly what I want and need...more Love, Joy, Peace, because they have definitely been sucked out of my life in 2006. As I listened to the next couple weeks of teaching, I learned a great deal from this TV evangelist about being offended and how offense is a tool the thief uses to destroy. He is a subtle one...and if he can't outright steal our love, joy, peace through outward events...he will work to inwardly destroy it through offense.

Being offended...now there's a topic. Who hasn't been offended this year by someone? Sadly we've likely been offended by each other right here in our own church body as well. (Or as one teaching pointed out...we often even offend ourselves!) I knew, without a doubt, that I was greatly offended by having to give up my work, keep Libby at home and fight the school system for the education she needed. Ok, so I'm offended, now what?

I was blown away to learn that REPENTANCE was the cornerstone of getting rid of offense. Step one – I was to repent. Me? Wait a minute God! I didn't "do anything"!! I was the victim. I mean, really God, who wouldn't be offended by all we've been through????

Repent, anyway...was the answer. Now repent, as Pastor Jim has taught in the past, is like making a u-turn. It's not just asking for forgiveness, but is actually turning around and going the other direction. Repenting when you're offended is like saying, "Ok, I'm going to lay down my victim mentality and the hurt I feel and pick up that shield of faith, strap on that armor and let God defeat the thief!" I'm going to humble myself and get out of the way...so God can work through me.

It's been a tough year at PSFUMC, too. It's been heart-breaking to watch our church family endure so much. So many have had loses, health issues, financial issues, family strains. And as a church family, the fruits that have grown so abundantly at PSFUMC for so many years have seemed stale. A sadness has fallen over us all. If the thief can't steal it...he'll kill or destroy...

Yet...we know, love, serve and worship the ONE who can stop all this thievery! And to quote one of the Pastor's recent sermons yet again, "God usually works *through* us." So, it's my prayer that in 2007 we will commit to allowing Him to work *through* us to stop the thief from stealing, killing and destroying our abundant life! Whether we're hurt, offended, saddened, exhausted or overwhelmed, I encourage each and every one to do that u-turn, put on that armor, and let God lead our battles. Living that abundant life is the best way to show His light to an offended/offensive world.
