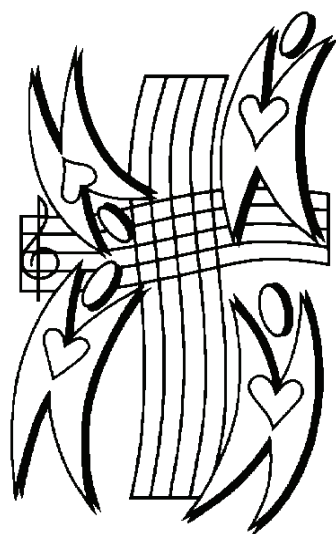

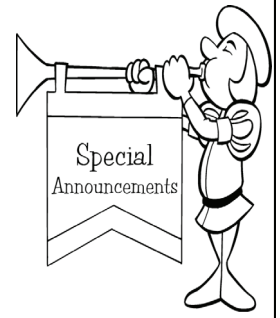

The following is from Julie Howell about their neighbor's son, Craig Magnon. The church sent a "We Care" package to him this month, along with packages from individual members. From Julie's message it sounds like Craig is truly in harm's way...we all need to keep him in our prayers. *Bobbie Bennett "I heard from Craig. I just hated reading his email. He has received one box from you with candy and newspapers. He said he and his Lt. appreciated it as he shared with him. He said a large postal truck carrying packages was destroyed by enemy fire. He wonders if your other box (of the first two you sent) and my first calling card I sent were on it. He hasn't gotten that either and I mailed it around the time you sent a box a while back. He said where he sleeps is close to the road where all this enemy fire is going on. He said he sleeps with sandbags piled around him. Makes me sick for him." Julie Howell*

Our May "We Care" package will be sent to 1Lt Ted Mugnier, USMC. He is on a Border Transition Team on the Iraqi/Syrian border. Here is an excerpt from Ted's note: *"I am part of a unit that is responsible for training the Iraqi Border Police on properly securing their border from the insurgent smuggling routes that allow the terrorism to continue throughout Iraq. I am sure you have read many stories of how so many guys have it so tough out here. Well, let me paint you a picture. We are co-located with an Iraqi Border Fort, we have our own little Marine Compound snuggled close to the fort. Our power comes from two 220v generators that can only be run certain hours in the day due to our fuel situation. We get to take showers, Navy showers that is, every three days due to our water situation. If you don't know what a Navy shower is, it is where you get wet, turn off the water, lather up, then rise off. The water doesn't run more than one minute during the whole shower. Our food on patrol comes mostly from the Iraqis - slaughtered lamb and unfresh vegetables. Back at the compound we are limited to eat mostly unhealthy frozen foods such as pizza and hot pockets. So what could we use? healthy food would be a start. Packaged tuna, whole-wheat products, canned vegetables, etc. as our cooking situation is slow. We have a very small George Forman grill, we could use a large family size one. The coffee pot we have is on its last leg, a very cheap 5 dollar pot that has been used for over a year. We could use a large coffee pot preferably 220 volts, but we do have a few 110 transformers, if not available. Honestly, any generosity would be truly welcomed. We Marines are proud to be here and would still be here even if we had to eat MREs every day." My eyes were full of tears as I read Ted's note. Packets of tuna, chicken, canned fruit and vegetables, etc. - as well as wet wipes. I'm sure if we shop around we will be able to find items that will be both easy to ship and prepare.
